Position Purpose

This role is a National industry leadership role which directs and oversees a dynamic MLA RD&A consultation strategy. This strategy increases the relevance, awareness and perceived value of MLA and its RD&A activities to all stakeholder groups.

The producer consultation manager oversees the implementation of the RDA producer consultation strategy including

- i. determining, understanding and prioritising the research, development and adoption priorities for on-farm research in Australia
- ii. creating and maintaining strong relationships between industry stakeholders
- iii. improving awareness of MLA RD&A activities
- iv. making sure these priorities align with industry strategic plans under the Red Meat Industry Strategic Plan (Red Meat 2030) and MLA strategic plan

The strategy is implemented through an industry wide network that includes regional research councils, regional subcommittees and national Red Meat Panel. These research councils includes North Australia Beef Research Council (NABRC), Southern Australia Livestock Research Council (SALRC) and Western Australia Livestock Research Council (WALRC).

The Producer Consultation Manager will also support the coordination of producer panels and committees across adoption programs such as Producer Adoption Reference Group (PARG), National Livestock Genetics Consortium (NLGC), BeefUp/MeatUp producer working groups. This will ensure alignment and coordination of Producer Consultation across Research, Development and Adoption at MLA with investments delivering impact based on producer and industry priorities.

Key Accountabilities

- Lead and manage the MLA Producer Consultation Program (producer consultation process and the prioritisation and contracted process) and be the central point of contact for the industry
- Manage monitoring and evaluation of Producer Consultation Program and implement continuous improvement as required.
- Support NABRC, WALRC and SALRC chairs to develop and achieve the key objectives of RAC committees
- Participate in, and assist with coordination of, PARG, NLGC and BeefUp/MeatUp producer working groups
- Assist in the develop of terms of reference with MLA Program Managers for projects that address key producer priorities
- Manage contracts with NABRC, SALRC and WALRC and ensure they follow good governance processes
- Support the chair of the Red Meat Panel with strategic direction, charter of operations and meeting organisation
- Coordinate and participate in RAC and Regional Beef Research Committee's priority setting process.
- Work with the MLA adoption team to integrate extension and adoption into new R&D investments

Other accountabilities

- Participate in approval meetings for Production and Animal Wellbeing (PAAW) and Adoption and Commercialisation groups
- Active member of the RDA Senior Leadership team
- Provide support to project officer/s to assist with delivery of Producer Consultation Program.
- Build relationships with other Research and Development Corporations to find potential synergies within the consultation processes
- Work with MLA program managers to keep up to date with key project progress and changes
- Prepare Board reports for the MLA board updating the progress of the consultation structure to achieving the stated objectives and the management of investment priorities.
- Undertake effective measures to ensure compliance with MLA's policies and procedures in workplace health and safety as applicable to self, other Workers and all activities within area of responsibility and control. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Provide information, instruction, training and supervision to workers
