Position Purpose

- To lead the Sustainability Framework and Environmental Credentials team
- This includes managing secretariat services for the Australian Beef and Sheep Sustainability
 Frameworks, the management of data collection projects and coordination of research and
 adoption programs within MLA to deliver on the framework priorities or awareness in consultation
 with the sustainability steering groups and advisory boards.
- There will be a primary and secondary contact for each framework (each shared), with Program
 Manager taking responsibility of one primary species lead, and the Project manager taking
 responsibility for the other species lead as required.
- Management of MLA's environmental credential platforms.
- To explore Environmental credential and market opportunities which benefit Australian red meat producers profitability.

- Develop adoption and extension programs to lead to year on year increase in producers accessing environmental market opportunities.
- To align sustainability RD&A activities with cross sectional RD&A programs within MLA.
- To develop and implement national and international collaborative partnerships that deliver against MLA investment plan program areas and provide key industry leadership for MLA with industry RD&A committees.

Key Accountabilities

- Research service provider procurement in accordance with MLA Policy.
- Evaluation of project applications submitted to the MLA and, where appropriate, other R&D partners.
- Negotiation and execution of contracts for research in accordance with MLA guidelines to ensure that intellectual property is adequately protected.
- Management of R&D projects with MLA procedures in order to achieve outcomes within specified time limits and budget.
- At the request and approval of MLA management attend industry forums, workshops, seminars and conferences.
- At the request and approval of MLA management conduct business development and opportunity scouting for RDA activities to benefit the red meat industry.
- Participation in MLA business and annual investment plan development.
- Provide quarterly reports as required on program and project performance to MLA management and update peak industry bodies.
- Regular travel (up to 40% of time) for project management, industry consultation and innovation finding purposes.
