Position Purpose

To undertake compliance activities in line with ISC's quality and compliance frameworks and to ensure that nonconformities identified across ISC's programs are actioned in a timely manner to minimise the risk to the red meat industry and ISC.

Key Accountabilities

- Undertake ISC compliance activities including preparation of datasets for LPA targeted audit program, NLIS device supplier audits and ISC's Quality Management System (QMS) internal audit program.
- Implementation of surveillance activities and associated nonconformities management framework including out of LPA audits, NLIS device supplier audit program and the ISC QMS.
- Coordination of NLIS Animal Identification Technology (AIT) Approval Program device assessments (including trial requirements, collation of field trial data, preparation of field trial reports).
- Development of processes and procedures to underpin quality and compliance activities.
- Reporting outcomes of compliance activities and making recommendations for action and improvement.
- Preparation of papers and reports for various ISC Committees in relation to compliance and quality activities and recommendations for improvement.
- Comply with MLA's policies and procedures in workplace health and safety as applicable to self, other Workers and all activities within area of responsibility and control.

- Compliance with the requirements of the company quality management system, including all relevant procedures and work instructions.
- Ensure all project maintenance and creation is carried out in SAP.
- Ensure all purchasing carried out in line with MLA Purchasing Process in SAP.

Major Challenges and Complexities

- Investigating and assessing compliance with program standards and rules, sourcing required evidence and establishing clear recommendations for action.
- Ensuring that compliance is assessed in an impartial manner and that recommendations are made in line with agreed risk-based frameworks.
